



Facilitated Dialogues

Exploring goals and vision through structured conversations that uncover core values and aspirations.



Identifying strengths and areas for improvement across all aspects of operations and artistic work.

Informal Audit

Mission and Vision Alignment

Refining or creating foundational statements that authentically represent the artist's purpose.

Action Plan

Developing a roadmap tailored to organizational priorities with concrete milestones.

By graduation, Fellows are equipped with mission and vision statements, a communication plan, strategic plan, updated website, grant writing and sponsorship development skills, basic budget, functioning board (if applicable), and initial financial reserves.

Fellow Commitments

To ensure a transformational experience, NH Dance Accelerator Fellows are expected to fully engage in the program (5 - 10 hours each month).

Active Participation

Fellows are expected to attend and actively participate in all scheduled workshops, mentorship sessions, and networking events.

Marketing Acknowledgment

Fellows will co-brand their materials or visibly acknowledge NHDC's support in their communications—such as websites, social media, playbills, and promotional materials.

Progress Reporting

Fellows will provide brief progress updates throughout the accelerator to track growth and ensure alignment with their stated goals.

Community Mindset

Fellows are selected not only for their talent and potential but for their willingness to contribute to and grow within a statewide network of artists committed to cultural impact.
